What is Eyeview?

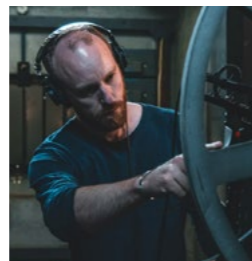
A series of place-specific artist commissions, participatory projects and community actions running throughout 2019 to offer fresh perspectives on the places and spaces that make Torbay unique.

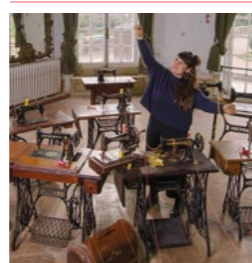
The Cave Hunters and the Truth Machine | Sean Harris

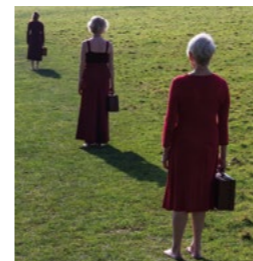

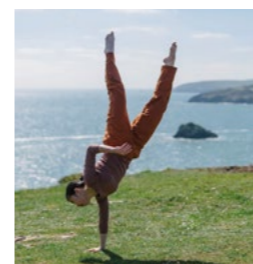

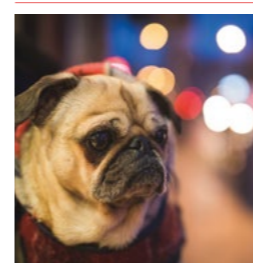
Silence Between Waves | Richard Chappell Dance

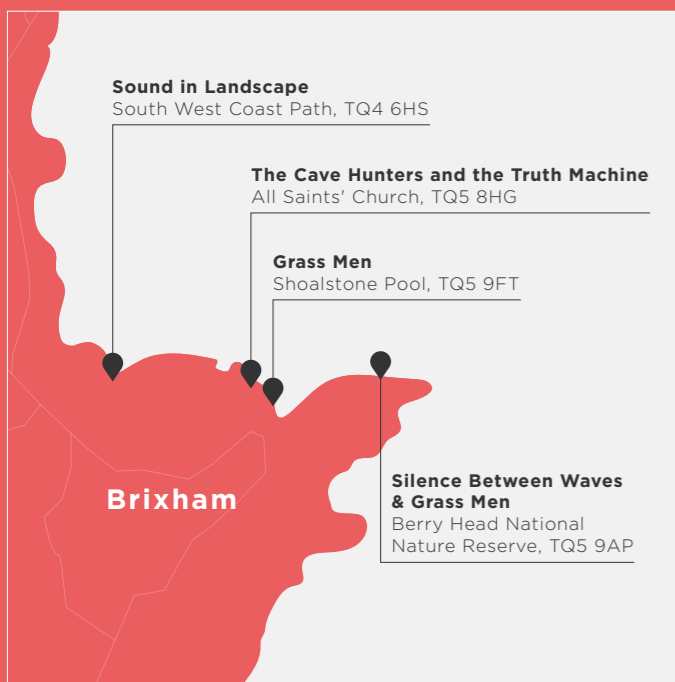
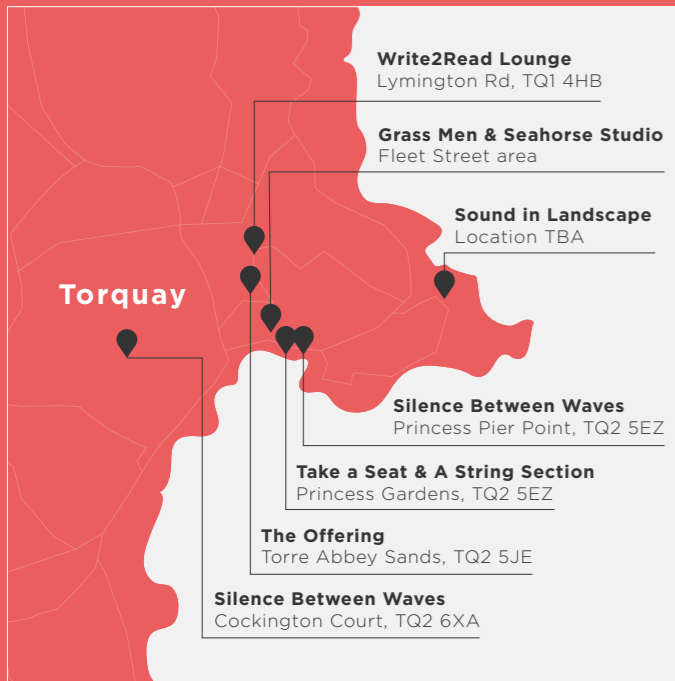
